


Facilitator Guide

Summary

We are in the midst of a spiritual culture war, in which the enemy attacks life itself. The true enemies are evil spirits, not politics or one another. In mislabeling each other the enemy we are fulfilling our true enemy's deepest ambition. God desires our minds and hearts to be transformed, so that our behavior may also be transformed. Despite the challenges we face, we must be assured of certain victory and remember that the ultimate battle has already been won by Christ's sacrifice on the Cross.
